## VILLAGE OF SHELL LAKE BYLAW 4-2019

## RECREATIONAL VEHICLES BYLAW

The Council of the Village of Shell Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. The name of this bylaw is to be known as: Recreational vehicles Bylaw 4-2019
- 2. "Dwelling" means a complete building or self-contained portion of a Building used by a household, containing a kitchen, living, sleeping and sanitary facilities intended as a permanent residence and having an independent entrance either from the outside of the Building or through a common area inside the Building. Dwelling shall also mean Dwelling unit.
- 3. "Recreational Vehicle" means a vehicle primarily designed as temporary living quarters for recreational camping or travelling, which either has its own motor power or that can be mounted to or drawn by another vehicle. This includes fifth wheels, conventional trailers, tent trailers, truck campers or motorhomes.
- 4. Only one (1) recreational vehicle per dwelling may be stored on a lot regardless of the number of adjacent lot(s).
- 5. Visiting recreational vehicles are allowed to stay up to two (2) weeks
- 6. Any person not abiding by this bylaw will be charged at a rate of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) per day from date of notification. Non-compliance will result in penalties set by the General Penalty Bylaw of the Village.
