ATHAKAKOOP TRAINING FACILITY

The Chief and Council of Athakakoop Cree Nation are pleased to announce the acquisition of the former Shell Lake public school in the Village of Shell Lake.

The remodelled facilities will be opening its doors for the first time on September 29th, 2023. The public is invited to celebrate the occasion and to the join in the grand opening firsthand. The event will start at 1:00 pm at the former School in Shell Lake. The grand opening includes ceremonies for the blessing of the facility and lunch will be served. In addition, there will be invited guest speakers and invited political figures of the current government who give grand opening remarks.

“The facilities will create capacity and employment opportunities for our Band members,” Chief Larry Ahenakew. “We will offer Adult Education, Short Order Cooking and Health Training as starting training classes.”

The role of the facilities is the to ensure it’s First Nations members seize

the competitive advantage of it’s demographics within the labour market by ensuring trained graduates are provided with the academic credentials and learning behaviours needed to succeed in related work environments. The facility will work with community leaders to establish ongoing educational and training opportunities for the community designed to maximize the Human Resource potential of Athakakoop membership.
