HOMETOWN CHAMPION
Brooklin Fry started golfing with her family on the Memorial Lake golf course in 2014 when she was 9.
She entered the local drive chip and putt organized by Dennis Simonar the following year.
In 2016 Brooklin played in her first Junior tournament in Estevan and finished 4th in the U15 age division. A month later she played in her second tournament at the Wascana country club in Regina and won.
Two years later in 2018 Brooklin won all 4 of the MJT tournaments she entered in Saskatchewan. Later that year she was fortunate to also win the overall U19 Saskatchewan junior title at Moon Lake in Saskatoon at the age of 13. That same year she represented Saskatchewan in her first Canadian junior championship in Delta, BC
2019 Brooklin finished 3rd at the junior provincials and went on to be the first junior girl since Brooke Hobson of Prince Albert to make the cut at the Canadian junior nationals.
2019 also saw Brooklin playing in her first Saskatchewan women's amateur tournament at Moon Lake where she made the team and represented Saskatchewan in her first Canadian women's amateur tournament in Red Deer.
2020 Brooklin won the junior girls provincials for the second time and became the first female golfer since 2010 to also win the provincial women's amateur title when Anna Young did it at the age of 17.
Brooklin is moving to Prince Albert this fall where she will be playing U18 AAA Hockey for the Prince Albert Bears. She plans to continue playing the two sports she loves, golf and hockey, as long as she can.
